International Friendship Day 2022

Our school will commemorate International Friendship Day on 7 April. This year, the theme for International Friendship Day is *Singapore in Asia*.

They will also be encouraging one another to actively recycle and cut down the use of single-use plastics.

Raising A Digitally Smart Child



Practise Appropriate Devise Usage

- Talk to your child about what they feel is an appropriate amount of time to spend on their digital devices per day given their commitments (e.g studies, CCA).
- Reach a common understanding on the time they should turn off their laptops and phones.
- Discuss with them what they can do online.
- Discuss with them what they should avoid, such as chatting with strangers, sharing personal details (home address, phone number), excessive sharing of pictures/videos of themselves.

Manage An Over-Reliance On Devices

- Identify specific behaviours (e.g thinking about an online activity even when offline or lying to conceal the amount of time spent online) and discuss realistic durations for your child’s screen time.
- Encourage your child to participate in outdoor activities instead of imposing a ban on device usage. Schedule these activities or do them together.
- Manage your expectations. Give your child time to adjust their digital habits. Acknowledge and show appreciation when you see them putting in the effort.

Handle Cyber Bullying

- Discuss with your child what Cyber Bullying is.
- Give them some pointers of how to deal with Cyber Bullying.

Encourage Cyber Kindness

- Discuss with your child how to be kind in their online interactions by leaving positive reviews, compliments, sharing uplifting content, practising empathy and respecting other users’ privacy.
- Remind your child that they should be accountable for their online behaviour by thinking before sharing or circulating any content.

Discern Real News From Fake News

- Use S.U.R.E to teach your child not to believe everything they read online.
 - Source – What is the origin? Is it credible and reliable?
 - Understand what you are reading by searching for clarity
 - Research by investigating the material and comparing it with multiple sources.
 - Evaluate the different angles and sides to a story.
