## School Safety and Security Reminders

The safety of all pupils and staff are of utmost importance to us and we would like to remind of the following:

- Please take note of the opening times of gates and adhere to security screening if you are visiting the school or dropping your child off at the school gates.
- If you have an appointment with a teacher/staff, please enter **only** via Gate 2 to sign out a Visitor's Tag at the Guard House and ensure that the Visitor's Tag is displayed prominently while on the school grounds. Do proceed to the General Office to meet the teacher/staff and return the tag at the Guard House before you leave. If you are driving, please park at the HDB car park near to Gate 4.
- Do drive slowly if you are entering the school compound to drop off or pick up your child and adhere to the yellow boxes indicated on the ground for the area of drop off.
- Parents who wish to pick their child up before dismissal time must report to the General Office to sign their child out.

## A Reminder

The school would like to continue to help your child grow to be more independent and responsible. If your child has forgotten to bring their books/ assignments/ personal items to school, do note that you need not make a special trip to school to hand them to him/her. If it is an urgent item that needs to be submitted, your child's teachers will contact you. Do remind your child to pack his/her bag daily so he/she only brings the necessary items to school.

### KEEP SAFE WHEN GOING TO SCHOOL

**1. BEFORE SCHOOL**

- ✓ **STAY HOME**  
If you or someone at home is sick with flu-like symptoms
- ✓ **WEAR A MASK**  
When out of home

**2. WHILE IN SCHOOL**

- ✓ **WASH YOUR HANDS OFTEN**  
Or use hand sanitiser
- ✓ **WIPE DOWN SHARED EQUIPMENT**  
Before and after use
- ✓ **MONITOR YOUR HEALTH**  
Take temperature daily
- ✓ **ALWAYS KEEP MASK ON**  
Take it off when eating/drinking; during strenuous activities
- ✓ **KEEP TO YOUR CLASS**  
Don't mingle with other classes
- ✓ **ENSURE SAFE MEASURES**  
Follow fixed seating rules, staggered arrival and dismissal times

**3. AFTER SCHOOL**

- ✓ **GO HOME QUICKLY**  
Don't hangout; avoid crowds
- ✓ **SPEAK SOFTLY IN PUBLIC**  
Avoid spreading droplets
