P1 Registration 2022- Phase 1

Phase 1 of the 2022 P1 Registration exercise will commence on 9am, 30 June 2022, and end on 1 July 2022, 4.30pm. Phase 1 registration is for Singapore Citizen (SC) or Permanent Resident (SPR) children who have a sibling studying in the school, and were born between 2 Jan 2016 and 1 Jan 2017 (both dates inclusive).

If your child is eligible for Phase 1, please submit the online form at <https://go.gov.sg/p1onlineform> by Friday, 13 May 2022. The school will contact you if additional clarifications and / or documents are required.

If your child is non-SC / non-PR and thus not eligible for Phase 1, please submit an online Indication of Interest between 31 May 2022 and 6 June 2022.

Travel Advisory

To ensure schools continue to be a healthy and safe environment for all, we require parents/ guardians to make a travel declaration for your child/ ward only if he/ she intends to travel for the holidays.

To make a travel declaration for your child/ ward via Parents' Gateway (PG), go to [SERVICE > DECLARE TRAVELS]

- For travel during mid-year holiday, please declare your child/ ward's travel plan(s) indicating both the country and city of travel, and any city of transit, by **27 May 2022 (Friday)**. Only one parent is required to declare.

If your child/ ward is **not travelling** during the holidays, **no action is required** on your side.

4 Tips to check in with your child about school



Children may not always voice out their fears or anxieties on their own. Make it a point to have regular conversations about what's going on in school and in their life, and make sure it's not just about their grades!

This will make it easier for them to open up when they are facing difficulties, and for you to pick up on what's troubling them.

Tip 1: Ask open-ended questions

Compared to 'Yes or no' questions, these can encourage your child to share more. If they are quiet, offer options.



Tip 3: Problem-solve together

It's tempting to offer solutions right away when your child shares his problems. Instead, listen and ask them to think about how they will address the situation and guide them towards their own solutions.



Tip 2: Follow your child's interest

Talk to them about things that get them excited or chaf about a school activity they mentioned. This shows you are interested in what they care about.



Tip 4: Be a role model

Share your own thoughts to show it's ok to talk about one's emotions and worries. Explain how you deal with your problems, and encourage your child to find ways that work for them.
