St. Magdalene of Canossa was born into the Marchesi Canossa family in Verona on 1 March 1774. Aware of the needs of the city's poor and guided by a profound religious search, she chose to serve God in dedication and service to the poor.

On 8 May 1808, upon leaving the wealth and security of Palazzo Canossa, she started the Institute of the Canossian Daughters of Charity with some companions and began the Charity Schools for children in Verona. Her belief was that every child reflects God and intent. She recognised that the education received by our children produces the fruits – the formation of the heart, the enlightening of the mind and the empowering of the spirit.

As we reflect on the academic year that has passed, we give thanks to God for our Canossian Sisters who love, care and pray for our children. We are blessed to have our Canossian educators who live out Foundress' mission in the guiding and teaching of our children. We are grateful for all our children whom we have witnessed grow and blossom; our children who have been blessed to be a blessing. And we give thanks for our parents who have journeyed with us hand in hand.

On 1 March 2023, we started our year-long thanksgiving for the 250th anniversary of Mother Foundress, St. Magdalene of Canossa, themed *Accendi La Vita* which means *Set Life on Fire*. Travel Declarations

To ensure that schools continue to be a healthy and safe environment for all, we require parents/ guardians to make a travel declaration for your child/ ward if he/ she will be travelling for the holidays.

To make a travel declaration for your child/ ward via Parents' Gateway (PG), go to [SERVICE > DECLARE > TRAVELS]. For travel during the school holidays, indicate both the country and city of travel, and any city of transit. Only one parent is required to make the declaration.

If your child/ ward is not travelling during the holidays, no action is required. When planning your travel, please refer to https://www.ica.gov.sg/enter-transit-depart for more information and updates.

If there is a change in travel plan(s) after declaration, please submit a new travel declaration via PG if there is a change in travel destination or inform the school if the travel plan(s) are cancelled.

Did You Know? At the time of her death on 10 April 1835, there were five houses of Canossian Sisters. Today the congregation has almost 4,000 members in 395 houses in 34 countries around the world and the "Canossian family" includes the Canossian Sons of Charity (priests and brothers – founded 1821) as well as the Canossian lay volunteers who carry out the works.

Every year, two national awards are given out to teachers in Singapore to recognize their professional excellence. They are the President's Award for Teachers (PAT) and the Outstanding Youth in Education Award (OYEA).

PAT gives national recognition to experienced teachers who are role models for the teaching profession. These teachers personify deep passion for teaching and inspire both their students and peers through their words and deeds.


OYEA gives national recognition to young teachers who are role models for the teaching profession. These teachers personify youthful idealism, energy and enthusiasm, and inspire both their students and peers through their words and deeds. Educators who are 35 years and younger are eligible for the award. Hence, OYEA 2024 is open to educators who were born on or after 30 June 1989.

National Institute of Education (NIE) Caring Teacher Awards (CTA) 2024

The Caring Teacher Awards (CTA) by NIE aims to acknowledge teachers in our school who go beyond the call of duty, nurturing the holistic development of their students and ensuring their charges grow up to be confident, independent and resilient learners for Singapore.


Family Fun for the Holidays

Does your child like to draw, paint, or sculpt?	Ignite your child's creativity by introducing them to art & craft activities! It's not always necessary to get new materials. Challenge them to use recycled or existing items at home. Immerse your child in the world of art at a visit to the museum. If you're feeling more adventurous, try a public art walking trail (https://www.roots.gov.sg/places/places-landing/trails/public-art-walking-trail)!	
Does your child enjoy helping in the kitchen?	Bring your child out for a picnic! You can get them involved in helping to prepare yummy picnic meals and encourage creativity in plating.	
Is your child curious and full of energy?	Explore Sentosa Island through home-based activity sheets to discover flora and fauna! Find out more about their resident animals and heritage sites and try to spot them when you visit Sentosa.	

Be physically and emotionally present when you spend quality time with your child. Showing an interest in the things that matter to them will help you understand each other better and strengthen parent-child bonds.
